

Dear [MS Name],

As Pride Month is celebrated across Wales this June, I am writing as your constituent to ask how you plan to support LGBTQ+ people during this Senedd term; and how you will encourage the Welsh Government to be bolder and more ambitious than the last.

Pride is a celebration of visibility and progress, but it is also a reminder that many LGBTQ+ people across Wales still face significant barriers in everyday life. Experiences differ greatly depending on where people live, their age, income, identity, or background. Too many people still struggle to access affirming healthcare, safe housing, or environments where they truly feel they belong.

I would welcome your views on three key areas in particular:

Health

How will you support timely, affirming healthcare for LGBTQ+ people, including improvements to mental health support, staff training, and access to gender-affirming care?

Housing

What action will you take to address LGBTQ+ homelessness and housing insecurity, particularly among young people and those facing family rejection or isolation?

Belonging across the life course

How will you help create a Wales where LGBTQ+ people feel a genuine sense of belonging at every stage of life — from schools and workplaces to community spaces and later-life care?

I also want to ask how you will ensure LGBTQ+ people from across Wales are directly involved in shaping future policy and decisions. LGBTQ+ communities are diverse, and policy should reflect the voices of people from rural communities, the Valleys, North Wales, disabled LGBTQ+ people, trans and non-binary people, LGBTQ+ people of colour, older people, and young people alike.

I am also concerned about recent changes in the EHRC guidance relating to trans people and the potential risks this may create. What steps will you and the Welsh Government take to ensure trans people in Wales are protected from discrimination, exclusion, and hate, and that equality protections are not weakened in practice?

This Pride Month, I hope you will champion a vision for Wales that is not only inclusive in principle, but ambitious in practice.

I would appreciate hearing about the actions and priorities you intend to pursue during this Senedd term.
